We do not publish "advertorials" or articles promoting products or services. We occasionally publish poetry and photo essays.

This is a popular newsletter and we are looking for contributors who can write simply and clearly, in concise, non-academic prose, rather than as professional educational "experts". We prefer our contributors to have had personal experience with the needs our client base faces, rather than merely the theory. However, accepted articles are well-grounded in research and theory, enabling readers to trust their content.

We do not, by policy, attach academic credentials or titles to writers' bylines. We will, at the writer's request, include them in the writers' biographies that may appear on our website.

We use gender-neutral language and appreciate our writers structuring their work to avoid referring to all people as "he". If necessary, accepted articles will be edited to reflect this policy. **The Remedy** articles include a sensitivity to a whole person approach to an individual's needs, health and environment.

We appreciate knowing if your article has been published elsewhere in the past, or if you have submitted it to other publications recently. We prefer to correspond with contributors via email; such queries are usually responded to within a few days.

We are unable to pay contributors, except in copies of the newsletter both in hard copy and via email. We encourage you to distribute your copies to demonstrate to your clients and prospective clients your level of expertise in this area. In addition your article will be archived on the WorkAid & Associates Website. If you wish to provide our web designer (conniehamilton_22@msn.com) your website link we can also include a link to your website from the WorkAid & Associate Website.

If you wish to submit photographs to accompany your article, they should be original prints of color photos or high resolution (300 dpi, 6-inches largest measurement minimum). Please include photo credit information and suggest captions (although we may not caption the photos). All photographs must be accompanied by a signed release. If the photographs have been taken by someone other than the writer, we require the release to be signed by the photographer.

Your article will be edited for spelling, punctuation, grammar, clarity, space and consistency in tune with the editorial style of **The Remedy**. If major renovations are required, your article will be returned to you for reworking.
